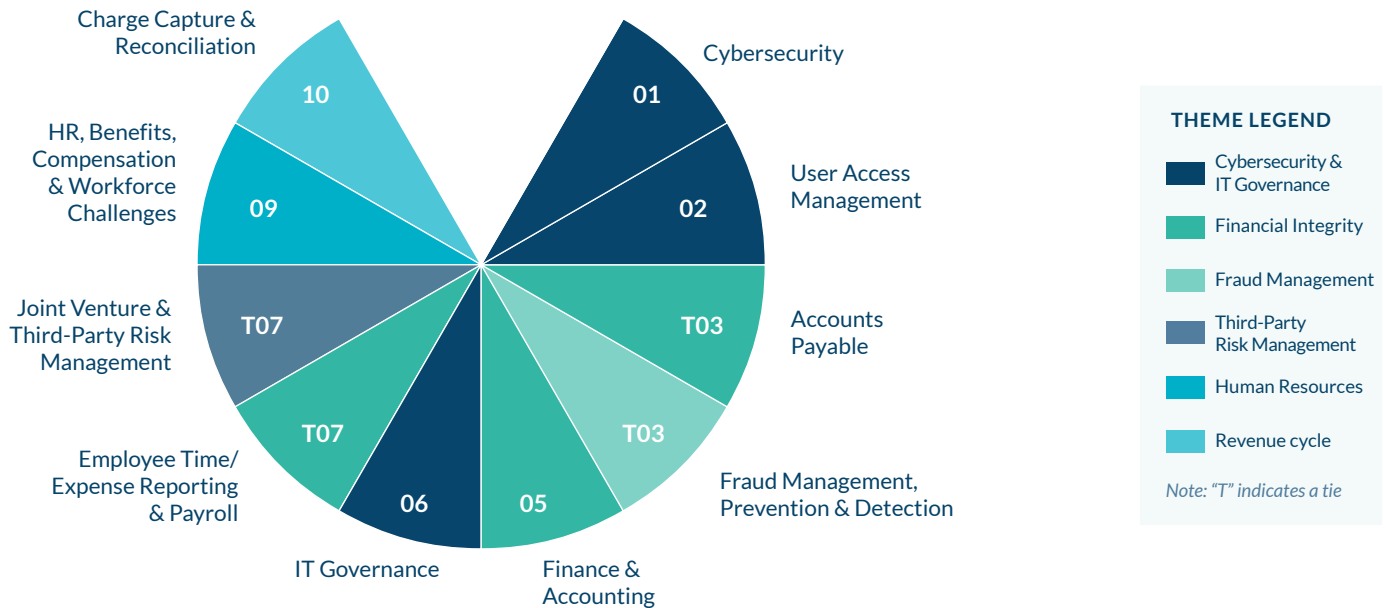


Navigating critical healthcare areas through internal audit

Top 10 healthcare internal audit plan priorities



Key highlights from this study



Cybersecurity is the top-ranked Internal Audit priority for healthcare organizations. Nearly **75%** of organizations include this on their 2024 internal audit plan.



While healthcare organizations co-source with a partner for a variety of specialty IA skills, **57%** co-source with a strategic partner or third-party vendor to execute IT audits.



55% of healthcare organizations report a low level of maturity in regard to use of artificial intelligence (AI). **30%** report not using AI at all currently.



52% include a component of fraud in all audits they perform.



In an increasing trend, **36%** of organizations perform a risk assessment on a more frequent than annual basis.



Among payers, **89%** list claims processing as their top priority for 2024.
